### Painting surface

9" x 12" Super Value Canvas by Artists Loft-8 pack  
and/or  
9" x 12" Acrylic Paper Pad by Strathmore- 10 sheets

### Brushes & Palette Knives

-White Synthetic Flat & Round Brushes by Artists Loft Necessities- or similar.  
9 round brushes (size 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9)  
3 flat brushes (size 3/8", 1/2", 3/4")  
-Optional brushes include fan and filbert style  
-A package of white plastic mixing/painting knives

### Paints

Many instructors ask that students do not buy the cheapest paints because they will not be happy with the results and frustrated with the painting experience. Paints are cheaper because they have more filler and less quality pigment, requiring more of it in a mix to make a pleasing color.
