## Supply List

- Watercolor Paper 140lb - Play with different Surfaces, CP, HP, R
- Ampersand Aquaboard
- Brushes, a good variety of sizes - Flats and Rounds
- Artist Grade Watercolors (love Holbein)
- Gouache - Holbein, Da Vinci or Windsor Newton\*
- Sumi Ink
- Graphite
- Water-soluble Graphite
- Watercolor Pencils and Crayons.
- Pebeo White Gouache (not necessary but extends your white gouache)
- Anything to make marks - Sticks, Chop sticks, combs, ect.
- Paper Towels
- Kleenex
- Water Container
- Spray Bottle
- Table Covering
- Reference Materials - look for large simple shapes to work with to begin.

\*Windsor Newton has a great 5 tube set that gives you the ability to mix any color you would need, or you may buy white gouache to mix with your watercolors but have a separate palette, so you don't contaminate your transparent color. You will need to use your tube paints to put out fresh.
