DIRECTIONS

Directions from I-95:

From I-95, take the W Indiantown Rd Exit (87A) in Jupiter and head east. Continue straight for approximately three miles.

Turn left (north) on Alt A1A.

Continue on Alt A1A approximately 1.2 miles crossing over the bridge. Turn left on E Riverside Dr. and then an immediate right on S Cypress Dr.

Continue on S Cypress Dr for approximately 1/3 of a mile. The art studio will be on the left. (1615 S Cypress Dr, Suite 1)

Directions from Florida Turnpike (toll road):

From the Turnpike, exit 116 and follow the same directions as above.

SUPPLIES

Paint:

It would be great if you could set up a palette before you arrive. It should have at least a couple blues, reds and yellows and hopefully some additional bright and fun colors that you like. I use a Frank Webb palette that you can get at Cheap Joes art supply. I like it because there are

no barriers between the paint and the mixing area. I also use Cheap Joes American Journey watercolor paints. They are good quality and come in big tubes. I like other brands as well...Daniel Smith, Windsor Newton, Holbein. My one request is that you buy professional-grade paints, not student-grade. I know

they're more expensive but the results will make you glad you spent the extra money. There are two colors I would love for you to include on your palette...cobalt blue and permanent rose. We'll mix these two to make a wonderful shadow color.

Paper:

Please bring several sheets of good quality watercolor paper or a watercolor block and a couple of scraps for practice. I am partial to Arches bright white rough but many artist prefer the smoother texture of coldpress. I have also been experimenting with Fabriano and have found it to have some interesting qualities. The size of the paper is completely up to you. If you are new to watercolor or haven't painted in a





while, you might consider choosing something on the smaller size.

Brushes:

PLEASE PLEASE PLEASE invest in at least one large flat 1.5 or 2-inch brush. We're going to be painting big and bold so we'll need some bigger brushes. A variety of other smaller flat and round brushes would also be helpful. Take a look at the wide variety of brushes I use. I know they can be expensive but if you buy a set, the cost can be a little more reasonable. Good brushes lead to good paintings and we all want that!



Sponge and Paper Towels:

Please bring a large, flat sponge available from any hardware store and a roll of paper towels. We will use these to control the amount of water that gets added to our paintings.

Other supplies that would be nice to have:

- Sturdy board with clips for paper
- container for water to wash brushes
- pencil
- kneaded erasure

Value Drawings:

My painting technique involves planning before we paint so I will be providing you with a value drawing for your use. There is no need to bring photos or reference materials unless you wish to paint your own subject. I won't be providing the value sketch until the day of the class but feel free to practice your drawing skills before the workshop!

Breakfast/Lunch:

Water, coffee and donuts/pastries will be available throughout the day. Midday we will take an hour break for lunch so feel free to bring your own lunch or if you prefer to go out, there are several restaurants nearby.
