

DRAWING CLASSES SUPPLY LIST

(most of these can be purchased at Micheal's, Easel Art or on Amazon)

Derwent, General, or Faber-Castile Graphite pencils in a tin and with a little sharpener (on amazon) (at least an HB, 2B, 4B, 6B, 8B).

These brands are worth the few extra dollars over cheaper brands.

Charcoal pencil (General's) ex-soft

Charcoal rectangular stick (Generals)

Soft or extra soft Carbon pencil

Prismacolor or Pigma Micron black 05 pen (or equivalent)

Small container of black ink (india, sumi, or any drawing ink)

Paper stump

Kneaded eraser

White plastic eraser

Ruler

Sharp scissors

Sketch book: 6 x 9 or 5.5 x 8.5 side spiral

(least expensive: for notes, class quick sketches, daily sketches)

Drawing pad: 9 x 12 for beginners - 11 x 14 for intermediates.

(either) Strathmore 400 series Drawing Pad 80 lb. weight paper (spiral)

(or) Canson XL Drawing Pad 70 lb paper (spiral)

Drawing board approximately 13 x 16 (anything stiff to put your pad on so you can tilt to draw)

Roll of 1/2" masking tape

And bring anything else you like to use for drawing!
